


COVID-19 Economic support for Business Update





The ACT Government announced a range of measures to support local business and industries impacted by the recent COVID-19 lockdown.

The Commonwealth and the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) Governments jointly funded the COVID-19 Business Support Grants in line with the extension of the ACT Lockdown to 2 September 2021.

Support if you couldn't work due to an ACT COVID- 19 Public Health Order

If you don't get a Centrelink payment

How much you can get?

- Lost at least 8 hours but less than 20 hours or a full day of work for that week, you'll get \$450 if you are eligible.
- If you lost 20hrs or more for that week, you'll get \$750 if you're eligible.

Who can get it? Eligibility criteria

- You're an Australian resident or hold a visa that gives you the right to work in Australia.
- You're 17 years or older
- You didn't get any of the following payment:
 - a. Income support payment
 - b. Dad and partner pay
 - c. Parental Leave Pay or ABSTUDY Living Allowance during the same period
 - d. Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment
 - e. Lost income and didn't have any pandemic-related paid leave entitlements
- You lived or worked from or visited a Commonwealth-declared COVID-19 hotpot in the ACT that is subject to a restricted movement order.
- Unable to earn your usual income of 8 hours or more because you were in the COVID-19 hotspot or restricted movement.
- You're not getting your usual income and your employer is not getting Retaining Domestic Airline Capability payments on your behalf.

How to claim?

- Claim online- MyGov Account linked to Centrelink or
- Work right visa holder must call on 180 22 66

What you need to do if you get this payment?

If there are any change in circumstances should be communicated within 14 days:

- your employment such as your employer
- your hours of work compared to the last claiming period
- your bank account details
- your residence status
- where you live or work.

Support if you couldn't work due to an ACT COVID- 19 Public Health Order

If you get a Centrelink payment

How much you can get?

- You can only get one \$200 payment each week;
- You'll continue to get your regular income support payment on your usual pay dates.
- You'll get automatic payments into your account within 7 days of the date the claim opens.

Who can get it? Eligibility criteria

- You get an income support payment or ABSTUDY Living Allowance
- You're 17 years or older
- You're not getting any of the following.
 - a. Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment
 - b. Dad and partner pay and Parental Leave Pav
 - c. A territory pandemic payment or a small business payment for the same period.
- You lived in, worked from, or visited a Commonwealth-declared COVID-19 hotpot and subject to restricted movement.
- Unable to work and earn your usual income of 8 hours or more or a full day's work because you were in the COVID-19 hotspot and are subject to restricted movement
- You don't have any pandemic-related paid leave entitlements.
- You reported employment income at least once on or after 19 June 2021 or had declared ongoing employment income on or after 19 June 2021.
- You're not getting your usual income.

Claim online- MyGov Account linked to Centrelink by using Centrelink Customer Reference Number (CNR)

What you need to do if you get this payment?

If there are any change in circumstances should be communicated within 14 days:

- your employment such as your employer
- your hours of work compared to the last claiming period
- your bank account details
- your residence status
- where you live or work.

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Payroll tax waivers

Payroll Tax Exemption – Apprentices or trainees

Wages paid to new employees who are apprentices or trainees employed after 1 August 2020 are exempt from payroll tax from the start of their employment until 30 June 2022

Financial Support for Local Tourism Industries

Accommodation and Tourism Venue Operator support program – up to \$75,000

What	Eligibility	Timing
Eligible accommodation providers and private tourism venue operators can receive a full rebate on their fixed water and sewerage charges for the first two quarters of 2021-22	30 percent reduction in revenue in July 2021 compared to April 2021.	Applications are now open and close at 5 pm on 17 September 2021

Financial Support for Local Tourism Industries

Small tourism operator COVID Recovery payment – up to \$ 15,000

What	Eligibility	Timing
Eligible small tourism operators and operators can apply for reimbursement of up to \$15,000 per ABN for eligible expenses incurred in June and July 2021 under the Accommodation and Tourism venue Operator Support Program	 Demonstrate 30 percent loss of revenue in July 2021 compared to April 2021 Tourism businesses with a turnover between \$ 75,000 and \$10m per annum (can apply up to \$ 15,000 plus GST) Tourism businesses with a turnover between \$ 30,000 and \$ 75,000 per annum (can apply up to \$ 15,000 plus GST) Seasonal Tourism Businesses (can apply up to \$ 15,000 plus GST) 	Submit your application and supporting documentation vis SmartyGrants portal







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
